History

- CZ.NIC outsourced complete .CZ technical operations
- Community was not happy - high costs, no development
- Idea for a switch to in-house operations from DNS.BE, EURid and CENTR

D-Day 2.10.2007

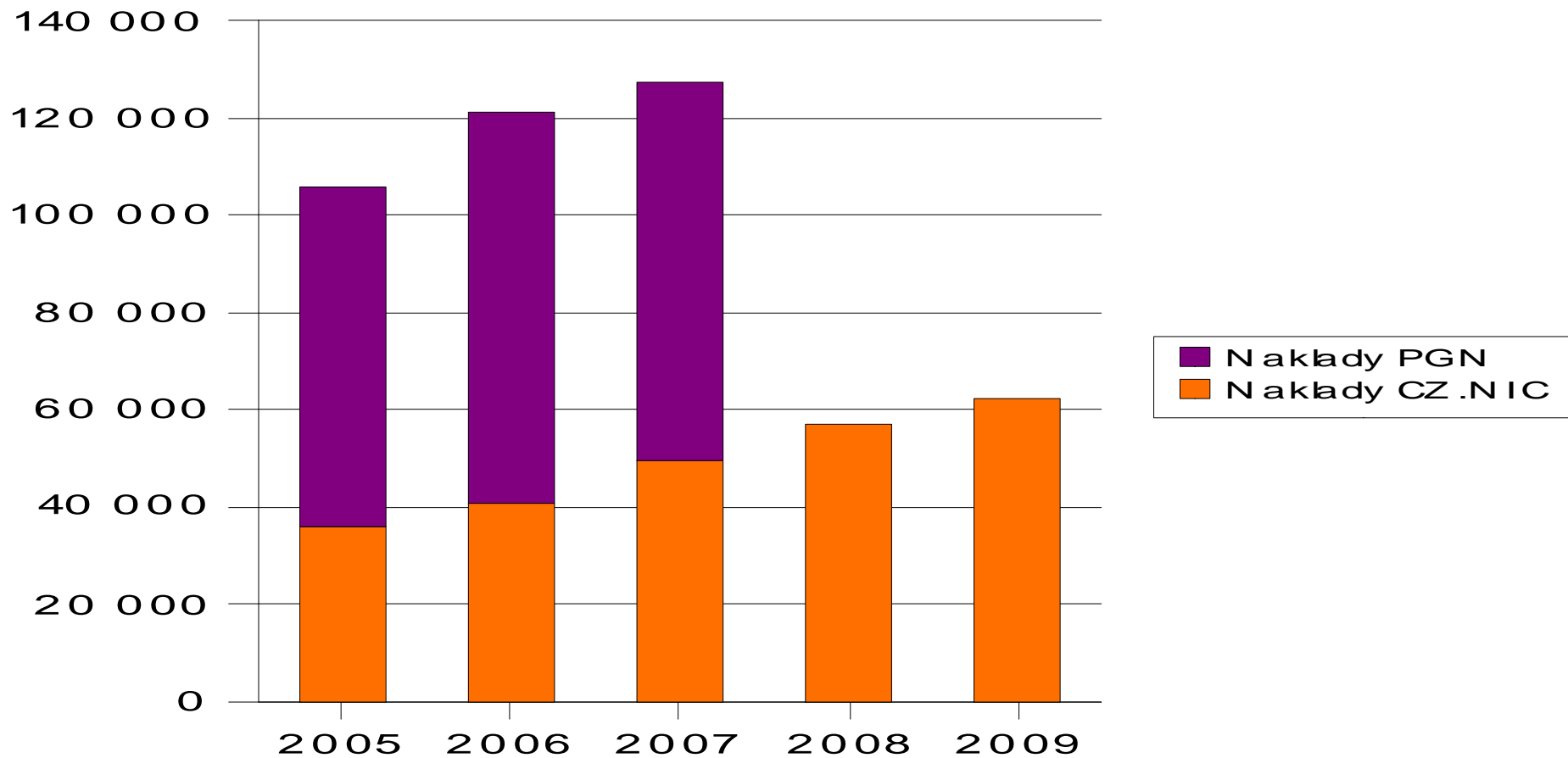
- 2.10.2007 we switched from outsource to in-house
- Without any tech problems (plan B,C)
- ENUM was also a test
- New brand name, logo
- Lower price
- Registr – Registrar – Registrant (only)
- We change also internal organisation model
- Our system is FRED

Cost

- Lower costs for more than 50%
- Faster technical solution (diff HW platform etc.)
- At “our hands” – no more outsourcing discussion what is and what is not at contract – extra money
- More internal employees, 7x24, building of know-how
- Now cca 450.000 .CZ, 4.400 ENUM domains
- No IDN yet, no demand

Cost history-future

mil CZK (1CZK=25.2EUR), Outsourcing, In-house.



ADR

- What to do if “my” domain is registered?
 - 1) Talk to owner
 - 2) Go to regular court
 - 3) Go to ADR
 - 4) ?? Register at another TLD

ADR

- ADR at CZ – Czech Arbitration court
- Location at Prague
- ADR also for EU
- Now at process of UDRP

ADR

- .CZ registration rules said about ADR
- Cooperation since 2000
- First complain 2005
- Up today 10 vs 84 standard court
- $\frac{1}{4}$ is refused and $\frac{1}{10}$ at piece
