Current UDRP issues

- UDRP providers do not deal efficiently with the most widespread types of cybersquatting
- UDRP proceeding needs a lot of printing, organizing and posting
- UDRP is quite expensive in terms of legal fees of expert lawyers
- UDRP is not multi-lingual



CAC Pilot means the following

- Parties will be able to communicate only electronically or with a single signed sheet of paper
- Complainants will have at their disposal comparative technical means as serial cybersquatters
- Class Complaints provide efficient legal procedure against large cybersquatters
- On-line platform enables lowering of legal barrier
- New on-line platform will be fun to use



ccTLD disputes, future of UDRP

- ccTLD registries may not be interested in UDRP-based model; this may be too restrictive for them
- Future is in robust ODR systems which will enable to build particular solutions for various needs of differing Internet players
- CAC offers this approach for all interested persons
